Living Liturgy

A Sign of the Kingdom: Healing

Continuing the typical day that began with last week's gospel, Mark shows Jesus engaged in a ministry of healing. Yet there is a suggestion that the excitement provoked by healing could get in the way of his ministry of preaching. Simon's mother-in-law is healed at home, away from the crowds. Her response is to wait on them. Healing leads to service in the community.

Healing is a sign of the kingdom of life that Jesus has come to inaugurate. He heals the woman on the Sabbath when such actions are forbidden. For Jesus, giving life to someone is more important than formal restrictions.

The suffering of the innocent, facing pain in our own lives and those we love, is never easy to understand or deal with. Doesn't God care? There are no simple answers, but hopefully, today's readings will point to some direction in which we may find strength and hope.

February 20 Deadline for Users of Columbaria

By now all those who already have the ashes of their loved ones at a parish columbarium, or who have booked a niche for future use, should have received a letter from their columbarium. This letter was accompanied by the official text of the new Terms and Conditions Governing the Use of All Parish Columbaria in the Archdiocese of Singapore. The letter explains how the new Terms and Conditions affect your use of the Columbarium. You are kindly requested to sign the Reply Form and notify your Columbarium of your agreement.

If for any reason you wish to terminate your use of the Columbarium, you should indicate this in the Reply Form and return the same to your Columbarium by 20 February 2012, failing which you shall be deemed to have agreed to the new Terms and Conditions.

The new Terms and Conditions were formally approved by the Senate of Priests and Archbishop Nicholas Chia on 24 November 2011 and promulgated as "particular law" of the Archdiocese for all parish columbaria – without any exception whatsoever – to observe. They will take effect on 1 March 2012.

Therefore, if it should happen that you have not yet received the letter and the accompanying documents, PLEASE CONTACT YOUR COLUMBARIUM immediately.
